COMMUNICATION

Please can all parents ensure that they read letters that are sent home? We will always email



a copy, even if a hard copy is required because of a return slip, as this is the only way we can guarantee it has reached you and not got lost in transit. Recently, we have had a number of parents claiming not to have known about clearly stated deadlines for returning replies to letters, or not to have read letters containing important information. We don't always get it right, but we do try very hard to send you the information you need. If you haven't read it after we have sent it, there is a limit to what we as a school

can do to rectify that. On a related matter, we recently had some concerns from parents who had not received text messages sent via the school's messaging service. We have raised the issue with eSchools who in turn have worked on this so the issue should now be resolved. Sometimes different mobile phone carrier companies experience delays in the text messages being delivered. The safest way to ensure you receive all texts and letters home remains to download the eSchools app onto your iPhone or Android smartphone. It's free from the App Store or Google Play. Once you have downloaded it, all your texts and emails will be sent to the app (together with a notification alert), rather than to your message inboxes. And finally - we cannot send a message if we don't have an up to date mobile phone number for you listed on your child's records, so please notify us immediately of any changes. Thank you!
