CLUSTER PACKED LUNCH POLICY



Thank you to everyone who returned a packed lunch
survey. In all, we had 38 responses from Westgate families and 335 across the cluster (Otley, Pool &

Bramhope) as a whole. It was very encouraging to read that 98.5% feel it is important or very important for children to eat a healthy, balanced meal at lunchtimes, and that 87.2% agree that a heathy school lunch can help their child to learn. 70.2% feel that schools should always or sometimes have packed lunch policy/ quidance in line with the School Food Standards. A small minority expressed concern at the proposal, feeling it would either be too restrictive or an intrusion on personal choice. The policy is intended to support parents in helping children to make healthy choices as part of a balanced rather than rigid diet.

There is a meeting at Westgate on Wednesday 22/06/16 at 18:00 for parents across the cluster wishing to find out more- all welcome.

DOMESTIC VIOLENCE NOTIFICATION PROJECT

A joint initiative between Leeds Children's Services and West Yorkshire Police is now in place to support children who are resident in households where there are incidents of domestic violence and abuse. It is designed to provide confidential notification to schools on any incidents of domestic violence and abuse which occur within a child's household that might have an impact on a child whilst they are in school.

The project will ensure that a member of the school staff is trained to allow them to use the information that has been shared, in confidence, and ensure that the school is able to make provision for possible difficulties experienced by children, or their families, who have been involved in or witnessed a domestic violence or abuse incident. We are keen to offer the best support possible to our pupils and we believe this is extremely beneficial for all those involved.
