WELCOME BACK

Everyone is delighted that the children are back at school this week. I am sure that all of us are experiencing a range of emotions: as well as relief that children are back in school, you might be worried about the possible impact on the local case rate, and also anxious about your child's emotional health and academic attainment- particularly given the very gloomy coverage in the media at the moment. I want to reassure you that we are committed to making the return to school as positive and productive for children as possible. Our approach to supporting children's emotional wellbeing is based on Westgate's 5 Rs:

- Reconnecting Relationships: helping children to re-establish social relationships and a sense of belonging at Westgate
- **Emotional Regulation**: helping children to manage their feelings as they negotiate the challenges they have been dealing with through the pandemic
- Routines: providing children with structure and predictability, making sure they are safe
- Resilience: giving children the tools they need to understand and manage challenge
- Reflection: to identify what they have achieved and to be proud of themselves

Then alongside this, we will be continuing with a broad, balanced and vibrant curriculum for all pupils. We know from our experiences last term that once children are back full-time in the classroom, with dedicated staff and great teaching, children can and will make very good progress. We are excited about getting back to enjoying learning. We don't want to focus on the deficit picture being painted in the press: your children have much to be proud of and we will be celebrating and building up.

And of course, we are beginning to plan special events and projects to celebrate our 150th anniversary as a school-something really special and positive for us all to focus on after the challenges of the last 12 months.

Finally, this week's online consultation evenings will be an opportunity to talk to your child's class teacher about your child's experience of lockdown and the return to school. Make sure you log on in good time for your appointments!

We continue to encourage and celebrate sustainable travel for your school journey. Don't forget that Scarborough Road is **closed to traffic** from

08:20 to 09:20 and 14:45 to 15:45 each day as part of the School Streets initiative. Children are rewarded for making active travel choices such as walking, cycling or scooting. Children in Nursery & Reception have their own cycle and scooter storage just inside the black gate, and everyone else has access to the cycle and scooter parking at the front of school. If you need to use your car, for example because of onward journeys, we have an agreement with Waitrose that parents can use the store car park for Park & Stride. 
Read on to see a summary of our recent parent survey about our remote learning offer during the latest Lockdown.

3. Have the remote learning activities provided by school been enjoyable for your child?






4. The amount of remote learning activities has been:







5. My child has been able to complete activities independently:
