### **PUNCTUALITY**



I would just like to take this opportunity to remind families of the timings of the school day. Doors open at **08:50** for Reception to Y6 and children should be here for that time so that they can be ready for registration and to start the day. School finishes at 15:15. Being late after 09:00 gives children a rushed and unsettled beginning of the day, often missing out on the important start to the first lesson of the day.

For Nursery children, morning sessions begin at **08:45** and end at **11:45**. Afternoon sessions begin at 12:25 and end at 15:25. Punctuality in terms of drop off and pick up is important, both in terms of a positive start for your child and avoidance of distress at the end of a session. Staff have short lunch breaks and meetings after school so lateness collecting has a knock-effect for other aspects of their work too, including preparation for the next session. Thank you for your support in adhering to these times. I will be writing separately to families who are persistently late at the end of this half term.
