# REFERENDUM VOTE TO REMAIN



Yes, you read that right! Last week, as part of their learning about balanced arguments in their English lessons, Y4 led an

assembly and provided the school with information- presentations and leafletsabout the arguments for and against leaving the EU or remaining a member. On Polling Day they organised a polling station in Y4 and the school was invited to cast their vote. The final result was 54 (27%) Leave and 146 (73%) Remain, with 95.2% turnout. It has been wonderful to hear children engaging in such an important issue and having the confidence to express their opinions as well as listen to opposing views.
