Dear Parents/ Carers

Arrangements over the Christmas Holiday

You may be aware that the government changed the guidance for self-isolation periods over the weekend. We have therefore amended the information below to reflect the change. Please read this carefully and disregard the advice in our previous letter dated 09/12/2020.

With regard to track and trace, the advice remains the same: if your child tests positive over the Christmas holidays, you **must** inform school. The table below sets out what you should do/ how to do this while school is closed.

Q How do I know when the period of self-isolation ends?

A To calculate the period of self-isolation, count the first day of symptoms as day 1 (or the day the test was taken, if you/ they were not symptomatic first). Day 11 is then the day that you/ they can resume normal activity/ return to school.



<p>My child tests positive for COVID-19, having become symptomatic within 2 days of them last being in school</p> <p>OR</p> <p>My child tests positive for COVID-19 within 2 days of them last being in school, and was not symptomatic prior to their test</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Child self-isolates for at least 10 days from when symptoms started (or from day of test if no symptoms) • Inform school immediately about results by texting 07891 279271, including: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ child's name; ○ date they became symptomatic; ○ date of test; ○ date of test result. • Whole household self-isolates for 10 days from day when child's symptoms started (or from day of test if no symptoms) even if someone else tests negative within the 10 days 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Contact all close contacts from their bubble and advise them to self-isolate for 10 days from the start of child's symptoms • Notify the local authority as required • Advise you on the date your child can return to school in January
<p>My child tests positive for COVID-19, but their symptoms started over 2 days of them last being in school.</p> <p>OR</p> <p>My child tests positive for COVID-19 over 2 days of them last being in school, and was not symptomatic prior to their test</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Child self-isolates for at least 10 days from when symptoms started (or from day of test if no symptoms) • Inform school about results by emailing head@westgateprimary.co.uk, including: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ child's name; ○ date they became symptomatic; ○ date of test; ○ date of test result. • Whole household self-isolates for 10 days from day when child's symptoms started (or from day of test if no symptoms) even if someone else tests negative within the 10 days 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Advise you on the date your child can return to school

If your child is identified as a close contact of someone with confirmed COVID-19 who was in school up to 2 days before they became symptomatic/ tested positive, we will notify you by text and email so that you know the period of self-isolation for your child.

You have all been fantastic at following the rules about self-isolation when someone in your household becomes symptomatic. These rules still apply. Your vigilance is what is stopping the virus from spreading widely within our school community. Thank you for your actions and support, both throughout this term and through the Christmas holiday which is now almost upon us. By being careful now, we can hopefully ensure that this crisis comes to an end sooner rather than later in 2021.
