



I am very frustrated to have to tell you that we have again been designated a polling station for the Otley Neighbourhood Planning Referendum on

Thursday 30/01/20. This means that we will have to close to pupils on this day, as the governors and I feel that this is the safest things to do. Staff will still be required to work, however. I would urge all parents affected by this to voice their concerns and ask our local councillors to redouble their efforts to ask Leeds City Council to identify an alternative polling place within our ward, and ensure that they fully understand the impact these closures have on you, our pupils and their learning. 
