5 Training Undertaken by Governors in 2021-2022

6 Chair of Governors' Statement/ Statement from the Governing Body

It was nice to have a school year that started to look 'normal'. This was most noticeable as all face to face meetings for the governors went ahead as planned. There was excellent input from members of staff, who kept the governors informed of developments in curriculum matters throughout the year, through a series of presentations, providing us with quality data and facilitating visits in school. The governors have seen some changes in membership, with some long standing members stepping down but we continue to recruit strongly and maintain a good level of skills across all the areas needed. The school improvement plan has continued to be well worked through and can be seen as a particular success for the management of the school. The end of key stage results were very pleasing, especially given the impact Covid has had on education, but everyone recognises that there is much work still to do in getting all pupils back on track. The education experiences offered both in the classroom and out have been fantastic and it is safe to say the everyone enjoys a safe and happy learning environment.
