Key Vocabulary

What the children should already know:

trust, internet, on-line, web content, trusted adult, safe, stranger, tell, share, real world, virtual, virtual world

accept- to click on/open something such as a link, advert or photo (Do not accept things if you are unsure of who has sent it to you as it may contain viruses.)

Meet- to meet someone you only know online (Meeting up with someone you only know online, even a friend of a friend, can be dangerous as this person is still a stranger)

Reliable- to trust something (You cannot trust everything you see online as it can be out of date, inaccurate or not entirely true.)

Password- a secret word, phrase, or group of numbers that a person must know to be allowed to enter a place or use a computer system

Personal information- information that tells other people who you are and where to find you such as your full name, address or school

Vocabulary of this strand: information, safety, key, question, password
