AU REVOIR A TOUT LE MONDE ET BONNES VACANCES! What a fantastic half term this has been in so many ways. The excitement of le Tour de France and Le Grand Départ coming, not just to Otley but right past Westgate, has created a fantastic atmosphere in school. As you know, we've taken part in a number of events to mark this special occasion:

- The whole school entered two t-shirt competitions (one run by Otley Methodist Church and one run by Otley Town Council) for children in Otley. In the first, Ben Davis in Y4 was overall winner for the town, with Tilly Maughan, Ben and Molly Hird all judged to be best in their age range for Westgate. In the second, George Lunn in Y4 was overall winner, with Ben and Ellora Green being 2 of the 3 runners-up in the town!
- We've had artwork displayed in Stephen Smith's as part of a Tour de France display.
- Mrs Pollhammer and Y2 have created a yellow flower and bicycle display for le Tour which is displayed on our railings on Ilkey Road- and it won a £50 gardening voucher in a competition run by Yorkshire in Bloom and the RHS!
- Children in Y5 and Y6 took part in a Virtual Velodrome cycling event at St Joseph's
- 150 children took part in singing workshops with Hope & Social, having learned their Grand Départ song, the Big Wide; then 60 children sang on stage with them at an open-air gig in Otley; and finally, 20 children joined them onstage at Leeds Arena to sing The Big Wide to open the Opening Ceremony of Le Tour!

This week sees lots of end of year events: Leavers' Play, Party and Assembly (tissues at the ready, please!); Sports Days; School Reports coming out. I would like to wish everyone a very happy and safe summer holidays- long may the warm summer weather continue. UNIVERSAL INFANT FREE SCHOOL MEALS

Most people who will have a child in Reception, Y1 or Y2 in September have now returned their slip to indicate whether or not their child will be taking up their entitlement to a free school meal from September. Thank you! Please could you return the slip if you have not yet done so.

As mentioned in a previous newsletter, lunch-times will be staggered from September in order to accommodate the additional serving time required. Reception and KS1 will have lunch from 12:00 to 13:00, while KS2 will have lunch from 12:25 to 13:20.

In addition, please note that the charge for meals in Y3-Y6 will be £2 per day from September. We are working with the catering agency to ensure a high quality of school meals which will hopefully encourage more children to take up their entitlement. HOLIDAYS IN TERM-TIME

Please note as you think about booking holidays in the coming academic year that holidays are not usually authorised in school time. Unauthorised absences equivalent to 5 days, consecutive or not, are referred onto the Attendance team and a fixed penalty fine of £60 per child, per parent, may be issued, rising to £120 if not paid promptly.

Where a child has been reported as absent due to illness but we have good reason to suspect that they were in fact on holiday, this will also be referred on if parents are unable to provide proof of illness. This is all part of national and local policy: thank you for your understanding in this matter.
