This summer we are saying goodbye to Miss Jeffery, who is leaving us to begin a teaching degree! We are very excited for her and wish her the very best for her next steps on the road to becoming a primary school teacher.

We have already begun transition meetings so that staff can hand over detailed information about the children they have been teaching and supporting. For children with SEND who need additional transition support, this will begin to be shared with families later this week. This Friday afternoon you will receive your child's school report via email. We are unable to send out hard copies this year due to the current extraordinary circumstances. You will still be able to comment on your child's report, however: further details will be contained within the letter which accompanies your child's report. The report format this year has had to be changed due to the unique circumstances, but next year's reports will revert to our standard format.

Yesterday, the education secretary, Gavin Williamson confirmed that it is no longer expected that primary schools will open to more year groups before the summer break. Given that we have no classrooms or teachers spare at the moment, I can confirm that Westgate will **not** be able to open to year groups beyond Reception, Y1 and Y6 this term. And finally, when we have any information from the DfE about how September will look, I will of course share more detailed plans. Thank you for your continued patience in this regard.

# HARDSHIP AND FOOD POVERTY



If you think that, due to changes in your circumstances, your child(ren) may now be eligible for FSM, please contact us via

info@westgateprimary.co.uk so that we can run an eligibility check. Your child may be eligible if you receive any of the following:

- Income Support
- income-based Jobseeker's Allowance
- income-related Employment and Support Allowance
- support under Part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999
- the guaranteed element of Pension Credit
- Child Tax Credit (provided you're not also entitled to Working Tax Credit and have an annual gross income of no more than £16,190)
- Working Tax Credit run-on paid for 4 weeks after you stop qualifying for Working Tax Credit
- Universal Credit if you apply on or after 1
  April 2018 your household income must be
  less than £7,400 a year (after tax and not
  including any benefits you get)

We also know that there will be families who are not eligible for FSM who may still be struggling. Please don't hesitate to email Ms Carpenter in confidence, as we can refer to Otley Food Bank and there may be other ways we can help too.

#### DOMESTIC VIOLENCE



While some families are enjoying having this extra time together, we also know that the lockdown may be putting significant

additional strain on family relationships. If you are experiencing domestic abuse of any kind, or if you are concerned about somebody else, there is help out there. Leeds Domestic Violence and Abuse webpage has lots of information that you can access without leaving an online trail, including emergency housing support. There is a 24 hour helpline 0113 246 0401 as well as daily online chat from 13:00-15:00 through Leeds Women's Aid. Finally, if you are concerned about your abusive behaviour towards your partner, Respect Phoneline (0808 8024040) can offer support to change.
