#### FRIENDS OF WESTGATE




Thank you to everyone who has already signed up for Easy Fundraising. We are already raising money through this scheme so please remember us as you start any Christmas

#### **PARKING ISSUES**



Parking enforcement officers have been present in recent weeks and have issued a number of fixed penalty notices to vehicles that were parked or stationary in contravention of

the restrictions on Scarborough Road. This is therefore a polite reminder that it is an offence to be stationary in the zigzagged area between the hours stated on the enforcement signs. This includes: being stationary with your engine running; 'just dropping off'; stopping on the middle of the road in the zigzagged area; being stationary in the zigzagged area waiting for someone to move further down the road. The reason for the restrictions is simple: stopping in the zigzagged area reduces visibility for pedestrians and increases the chance of a child being hurt. Thank you for your cooperation and understanding.
