## Directions to Westgate Primary School, Scarborough Road, Otley

## From Ilkley

You will come into Otley on the A660, at a large roundabout. Take the first exit at this roundabout, then turn first left into Scarborough Road (one-way street). The school is on the right.

## From Bramhope.

As you come down towards Otley on the A660, you will come to a small roundabout. Take the first exit. Travel along for about $1 / 2$ mile then you will come to another larger roundabout. Take the third exit, then turn first left onto Scarborough Road (one-way street). The school is on the right.

## From Guiseley

Take the A65 out of Guiseley, towards Skipton. Cross over the traffic lights by the Hare and Hounds, then you come to a small round about. Take the $2^{\text {nd }}$ exit (A 6038) towards Otley. Carry on until you come to another large roundabout. Take the $2^{\text {nd }}$ exit then the first left Scarborough Road (one-way street). The school is on the right.

From Harrogate / Pool.
You will enter Otley through the main shopping centre. Keep on that road, until you reach the $2^{\text {nd }}$ main set of. traffic lights. This is a staggered crossroads. Go straight over continuing on the A659. Follow that road round past Waitrose on your left and the Fleece Pub on your right. About 200 yards further on, just before you reach the roundabout, there is a little road on your right which is Scarborough Road (one-way street). Turn into this road and the school
is on the right.

## Parking

There is very limited car parking on site so it is easiest just to park on the street - either on Scarborough Road itself or on Ilkley Road which is often easier (right or left at bottom of Scarborough Road).

## Public Transport

There is a good bus service to Otley and the nearest train station is Menston, which is on the LeedsIlkley line with trains every 30 minutes. Please telephone the school for further details if you are travelling by public transport.
