CONSULTATION EVENING EVALUATION

Thank you to everyone who completed our short evaluation of our first ever hybrid parent consultation evening. You can view a summary of the responses here. 91% of respondents indicated that they were happy with their allocated type of meeting, and the vast majority were happy to have a choice. On the basis of this feedback, we will continue with the hybrid model for our next round of meetings in the spring term. Based on feedback, we will also ensure that we send books home for you to look at beforehand if you are meeting teachers online.

A small number of parents indicated that appointments felt short: 9-10 minutes is a standard amount of time for a primary school consultation appointment. If there are more in depth things you wish to discuss with your child's teacher, you should make a separate appointment outside of consultation evening. As a school, we must ensure that additional meetings like this fit into teachers' directed time and so it is not possible to lengthen appointments. Thank you for your understanding in this matter.
