# FRIENDS OF WESTGATE CHAIRPERSON (OR PEOPLE)

The Friends of Westgate are a key part of what makes our school such a friendly, close, community school, and they can't run without at chairperson- or two people to share the role.

#### As chair you would:

- Oversee the events through the year, checking that they are running OK by liaising with the teams that run each event.
- Chair meetings, check minutes and send out emails to all members on the distribution letters.
- Deal with any correspondence that comes to FOW.

- Have dedicated teams which take responsibility for and deal with the practicalities of each event themselves
- Be supported by the publicity officer, the secretary and the treasurer

Meetings are at The Fleece in the evening, once or twice a term only, and we can be flexible about the day/ time to suit the chairperson and attendees.

While the chairperson doesn't run individual events, without a chairperson FOW cannot run, which means no Easter Fair, no Disco, no Carnival, no year book... and no funds for school to purchase things like laptops, stage lighting, costumes, playhouses, the gazebo.
