A texture can look different to how it really feels. <b>Line</b> A line is longer than it is wide. A line can be straight or curved. It can be horizontal, vertical or diagonal and can change direction. <b>Fier 3</b> <b>Tone</b> The tone of something refers to how light or dark it is. Areas with lots of light are called highlights and darker areas are called shadows. <b>Collage</b> A piece of art made by sticking various different materials such as photographs and pieces of paper or fabric on to a backing. <b>Appliqué</b> is a design technique by which pieces of material are attached to another material.
