Dear Parents/ Carers

Full School Reopening

I am sure the prime minister's announcement this afternoon that schools will fully reopen on Monday 8th March came as a huge relief to you (as it did to me), after your incredible efforts with remote learning and juggling employment demands- and particularly the essential work that our front line critical workers are carrying out. I also realise that the announcement may also give you additional questions or anxieties.

This evening the Department for Education (DfE) has circulated updated guidance for schools which applies from 08/03/2021, answering several of the questions we had as a school. On first reading, the systems of control we already have in place seem set to remain for now, such as:

- Staggered starts and finishes
- Allocated entrance/ exit points for different classes
- Limited access to the school site for visitors
- Face coverings to be worn by staff
- Additional handwashing routines
- Social distancing where possible
- Limited social contact through class 'bubbles', including staggered breaks and lunch times
- Enhanced cleaning routines
- Limiting the equipment children bring to school
- Limiting the equipment children share in school

We still have other questions, including arrangements for special events visits, visitors and residentials, and I fully expect further information about systems of control in the coming days. I will update you as and when I am able, and will ensure you have full and clear details of the final arrangements for school's full reopening ahead of Monday 8th March. However it is reassuring to know that we have a strong, proven base on which to build.

Thank you for your understanding, patience and support. I look forward to safely welcoming all the children back to school next month.
